**UPDATE**

1. **Question:** Will the awarded contractor be responsible for the removal or any damages to the landscaping during construction?

**Answer:** The awarded contractor is expected to operate within reason and execute the demolition of the wall and the installation of the proposed railings with minimal or no damage to the existing landscaping. The contractor will not be held responsible for the replacement of any minor landscaping damages that occur during the demolition or installation process.

2. **Question:** Where can I find all the addendums associated with this bid?

**Answer:** Copies of the addendums for this bid can be found on demand star and the RBCRA's website at [www.rbcra.com](http://www.rbcra.com).

3. **Question:** What are the allowable hours and times the awarded contractor can have access to the site.

**Answer:** Contractors can operate on site 7am-7pm, Monday-Friday excluding weekends and major holidays.

4. **Question:** Will the ITB due date be extended.

**Answer:** The Deadline will be extended to July 13, 2018.

5. **Question:** Will there be a revision to the drawings to address the tie beam size?

**Answer:** The revised drawings will be uploaded July 2, 2018 by 5:00 pm, to address tie beam size to be reduced so that the bottom of the beam is aligned with the top of the pavers. The drawings will also include a dowel for reinforcing to connect the tie beam to the existing concrete block.
